Award Winning Documentary Comes to Park City: The Story of Six High School Students with Behavioral Issues Make A Dramatic Change

- Focus on the issues facing teens today

PARK CITY, Utah (March 01, 2017) – The Speedy Foundation in partnership with the Park City Library, the Park City School District, CONNECT Summit County, and Authentic Strengths Advantage is bringing the highly acclaimed and award winning documentary, *Paper Tigers*, to Park City.

Paper Tigers is a film that follows six high school students from Lincoln Alternative High School in Walla Walla, Washington where some of the students are emotionally stressed, living in danger and filled with pain. This film takes a close look at what is called Trauma-Informed Education, a movement that is showing incredible results in helping students struggling with the dark legacy of Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE). **Paper Tigers** captures how their teachers, who were ready to try a new way of educating these struggling students and positively changing their lives forever.

"Many children in our schools are getting in trouble or falling behind because of adverse childhood experiences, which are beyond their control. *Paper Tigers* brings these issues to light and provides a tangible solution to help end the cycle of adversity," said Katrina Kmak, Youth and Spanish Services Librarian at the Park City Library.

A free public screening of *Paper Tigers* will be held on Tuesday, March 7th from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. MDT at the Jim Santy Auditorium at the Park City Library.

Following the screening, Fatima Doman, Founder of Authentic Strengths Advantage, Bestselling Author and Positive Psychology Coach will share science-based solutions. During her 20+ years as a coach/speaker, Doman has helped organizations and clients around the world increase their resilience.

"Every school in every community has children who are suffering. By bringing this to light and addressing the problem in public, we are providing the opportunity to consider a new approach to helping our children," said Shannon Decker, Executive Director of The Speedy Foundation.

The results of a Trauma-Informed Education speak for themselves. Lincoln Alternative High School former principal Jim Sporleder was able to turn his school around by dramatically decreasing out-of-school suspensions, increasing graduation rates and students going on to get a post secondary education.

"We feel fortunate to have this feature film in our community, available for parents, teachers, health care providers and community members to view and discuss," said Kmak.

The film is free to all those who want to attend and Fatima Doman will host a presentation on resilience and positive psychology immediately following. Please make note that the film does contain profanity and may not be suitable for young children. There is no registration; seating is available first come-first serve at the Jim Santy Auditorium.

Paper Tigers is directed by James Redford and executive producer Karen Pritzker.
